At the Immunocardiology Lab, we approach the infarcted heart from a wound healing-oriented perspective and investigate how immunological phenomena contribute to tissue repair process. We closely cooperate with the Department of Internal Medicine and the biobank of the University Hospital Würzburg to bridge basic and clinical research in Cardiology.

We are seeking a **creative and motivated young scientist** to take part in a project on **immune repertoires and cardiac diseases**. The project is part of an **international consortium** including partners in Würzburg, Graz and Paris, offering the successful candidate exciting possibilities for international scientific exchange. Scientific maturity to develop projects independently, creative thinking, solid theoretical background, and previous experience in immunological methods (e.g. flow cytometry) are important pre-requisites. Additional experience in sequencing and bioinformatics would be very much appreciated. The selection of candidates will be based on scientific qualification, personal skills and potentially publication record.

Payment will be according to individual qualification and the TV-L. Disabled applicants will be considered preferentially in case of equivalent qualifications. Applications should include a cover/motivation letter, curriculum vitae, list of publications and a short description of previous research projects, names and contact details of 1-2 academic referees, and copies of credentials and certificates.
